A warm welcome to all our visitors to Temple Hill for today's Ulster Bank League game with **Clontarf FC**. We extend a warm welcome to Clontarf President, **John Glackin**, his committee, players and supporters, and also a special welcome to the former Constitution players who are lining out for Clontarf today.

Last week **Constitution** lost at home to **Garryowen** in a tight game that could have gone either way. A soft try conceded to Garryowen was the difference between the teams. That makes two away wins and two home defeats from the four games played. But with 10 points they still sit in fourth place, if only on points difference, over Garryowen and St Mary's College. A win today would again close up the league table.

For their part **Constitution** have played 28 different players and introduced 10 new players to the colours already this season. Thus the team is striving to find the form and fluency that was the mark of last year's successful campaign and they will have to be patient until performance and results meet the aspired ambition.

Meanwhile **Clontarf** have started the campaign with four straight wins. Last weekend they accounted for Lansdowne on a 25-13 score line. Before that they won 30-6 against Blackrock College in the first game, and followed up with a 16-15 home against Young Munster, before winning 9-6 at Garryowen. They have scored 80 points with **Richard Lane** contributing 43 points and are the form team in the competition at this stage.

Last season Clontarf comfortably won Division 1B to regain their status in the top division. They had gone down the previous season, not helped by losing the home and away fixtures with Constitution. With their squad bolstered by former Cork Constitution stalwarts **Frank Cogan** and **Richard Lane** and **Evan Ryan**, it is clear that they will challenge for top honours this season.
