Cork Constitution renew their old rivalry with Garryowen once again in Round 4 of this season's Ulster Bank League on Saturday next at Temple Hill. We are pleased to welcome Garryowen President, Christy Barry, together with his committee members, team and supporters to Temple Hill.

The game will also double up for the annual Trevor Barry Memorial Cup, and we especially welcome Trevor's sons Robert and James to Temple Hill.

We are also honoured to have Sean Kelly MEP as guest speaker at the Pre-match Luncheon. It will be recalled that during his term as President of the GAA 2003-06, he was instrumental in the opening of Croke Park for rugby during the re-development of Lansdowne Road. Rather amazingly, he is the first Kerry man to be honoured with the Presidency of the Gaelic Athletic Association. He has been a Member of the European Parliament since 2009, and has also served as Executive Chairman of the Irish Institute of Sports to support elite athletes and players.

In the Ulster Bank League Constitution have had a good start to the campaign, with wins over Ballynahinch and Lansdowne, while drawing 3-3 with Old Belvedere last weekend. Meanwhile Garryowen, surprisingly, have suffered defeats at the hands of Dolphin, Clontarf and UCD. So, expect a determined effort by the Light Blues to get off the bottom of the table, and get their season back on track.

Last weekend at Anglesea Road the conditions were very difficult due to incessant rain, and it resulted in the lowest scoring AIL tie for many years. However, after three games, it is clear that this season's competition is again going to be very tight, with only three points separating the top six clubs.

Over the 24 years of the All Ireland League, excluding play-off games, the tally of wins favour Garryowen who have won 13 of the 28 games. Constitution have won ten, with five drawn games. Incidentally, in the last two seasons, Garryowen have won at Temple Hill on each occasion, while Constitution have won the games at Dooradoyle in the reverse fixtures.

In this season's Munster Senior Cup, Garryowen have reached the semi final with big wins over Richmond and Cashel. They meet Shannon in the semi final on Saturday 16th November, while Constitution will play UCC in the other semi final at the Mardyke. So, today's game may yet be a rehearsal of another Munster Cup Final between the clubs in December.




