# Cork Constitution FC V Ballynahinch RFC Saturday 27th September 2014 14.30 PM **Temple Hill**

On Saturday Cork Constitution host Ballynahinch R.F.C in the Ulster Bank All Ireland League . We extend a special welcome to their President, David Napier, his committee and supporters.

In their last outing against Lansdowne Constitution were unlucky to get only a losing point. Despite being down 13:3 at half time and playing with 14 men Constitution raised their game after the break and held Lansdowne scoreless for the third quarter of the game. After a Lansdowne player was yellow carded Constitution scored immediately when Niall Kenneally got the touchdown after sustained pressure. The conversion was missed, but Constitution attacked with renewed spirit, and were rewarded when flanker James Murphy scored from a maul in the 76th minute. The conversion was again missed but the scores were now tied at 13 points each as the game entered injury time. The game was finally decided when Scott Deasy kicked a penalty in the 8th minute of injury time, and in the circumstances Constitution will be disappointed to let the extra point slip, as a draw would have been a fair result.

Ballynahinch will be in a buoyant mood after beating Old Belvedere last week for their first League win of the season and after beating Constitution last season in Temple Hill will travel with confidence. Constitution anxious not to lose further ground on the league leaders will be

### First Junior Cup Winning Captain

Peter Fitzgerald, Coleraine, will be 90 years young on 28th September next. Born in 1924 he captained the first Cork Constitution Munster Junior Cup Winning Team in 1949, beating St Mary's 11-0 at the Mardyke. This was a monumental achievement as Constitution had been defeated in nine previous finals. After the final Peter cycled back to West Kerry after the game, stopping in Macroom for a dance.

Peter Hill FitzGerald was born on September 28th 1924 at Camp, Tralee, Co. Kerry. He was the youngest of 5 children, the others now deceased. His elder brother Robert became well known in rugby circles, playing lock forward for Leinster and having been Secretary/ Treasurer of the IRFU for many years.

Peter declares that life was very tough growing up in the 1930's and generally avoided hard labour on the home farm and went off to Kings Hospital boarding school in Dublin where he too was introduced to the game of rugby football.

After leaving school in 1943 he worked briefly in Dublin before he was offered a job in the Bank of Ireland for the wonderful salary of £166.00 per annum. Of course the job happened to be in South Mall in Cork where he spent 7 wonderful years the highlight of which he proudly states was captaining Cork Con to their first ever win in the Munster Junior Cup in 1948. His affection for Con has never diminished despite being transferred to Tullamore and subsequently to the North finishing his banking career in Coleraine where he still lives. He's still a proud Kerryman and continues to have great interest in what happens in his place of birth. Hugh Donovan

Peter also thanked Pat O'Keeffe and Dave Fitzgerald who looked after the cards and made sure that the time sheet ran smoothly.






