Spectators are in for a treat at Temple Hill on the Jazz Bank Holiday Saturday when Cork Constitution host Young Munster in a mouth-watering all-Munster Division 1A fixture. We are pleased to welcome Young Munster's President, Frank Corr and his committee members, team and supporters to Temple Hill.

League places count for nothing when Constitution play Young Munster and another close encounter is in the offing on Saturday. It's two clubs with rich traditions, it's Cork versus Limerick, and it promises to be an intriguing tie. The last time the two sides met on a sunny day back in April, Young Munster prevailed 3-0, a penalty from Alan Tynan proving the decisive score.

In their last league outing title holders Cork Constitution suffered their second defeat of the season as former Constitution player Scott Deasy, with a personal tally of 19 points, guided Lansdowne to a decisive win on a score line of 24-10.

Young Munster will be disappointed with their result last time out against Trinity as they lead by 14 points at the 30 minute mark. Trinity turned things around in the second half thanks to tries from David St Leger and Jack Fitzpatrick, along with the place-kicking of Tommy Whittle who finished with 11 points. Young Munster had the consolation of climbing out of the drop zone after claiming a losing bonus point.

Last week-end Constitution got back to winning ways against U.C.C. in the Munster Senior Challenge Cup and Brian Hickey will be hoping that his charges will continue to show good form and extend their unbeaten home run in Temple Hill.

The game promises to be a tense affair and while supporters of both clubs may find the tension too much to handle it's definitely a game for neutrals to enjoy and savour.


