Munster Junior Challenge Cup Final

The prestigious Munster Junior Challenge Cup consistently produces finals which guarantee intense effort and skill with a bit of high drama thrown in for good measure. Saturday's clash between Constitution and Highfield in Irish Independent Park looks set to continue this tradition.

Cup holders Cork Constitution, looking to retain and win the cup for the 20th time, defeated Clonmel 60-12 at Temple Hill to book their place in the final.

Highfield defeated Cashel 29-3 in the other semi-final. Highfield play an entertaining style of rugby and have a proven match winner in Paul Downes who contributed two tries, three conversions and a penalty to their victory over Cashel.

They are bound to cause problems for Constitution who will have to play accurate and clinical rugby if they are to prevail.

Constitution are All Ireland Champions

Cork Constitution overcame the loss of Captain Niall Kenneally who was injured in the warm up to regain the All Ireland League trophy for a sixth time with a deserving 28-13 win over Clontarf in the final at the Aviva Stadium last Sunday.

Niall Kenneally was replaced by Alex McHenry before the kick-off and Ross O'Neill was added to the replacements & Brian Hayes took over the captaincy.

Clontarf enjoyed the opening stages but Constitution's first attack produced a great try with a break by Seán French setting up Shane Daly for the touchdown and Aidan Moynihan converted after eleven minutes.

A yellow card for McHenry saw Clontarf open their account with a penalty by David Joyce on sixteen minutes. The Dublin side were rocked minutes later when man of the match Rob Jermyn cut through the Clontarf defence to score and Moynihan's conversion made it 14-3.

Clontarf were inside the Constitution 22 for the second quarter and a lot of it close to the line with Jermyn again on hand to stop a certain try.

Clontarf's pressure was eventually rewarded from a quickly taken penalty when Matt D'Arcy barged over for a try and Joyce converted to leave it 14-10 at half time.

Constitution were on top in the early stages of the second half and when they opted not to convert kickable penalties it looked like it might cost when a Joyce penalty on 53 minutes left the minimum between the sides.

However, the introduction of Duncan Williams saw him touch down in the corner shortly after his arrival on the field after a break out from Jermyn.

Three penalties from Moynihan in the final quarter saw Constitution run out worthy winners.


