

Prepare a match report for Juvenile Rugby

It is a daunting task to write a match report so here are some ideas you may wish to take onboard:

- 1) Talk about the score and whether it was an exciting game to watch.
- 2) Talk about your team tactics and how well they went.
- 3) Talk about what you thought made your team or the opposing team win, don't be negative about either team or an individual, and don't pick individuals for man of the match.
- 4) Include the scores for each half and then the overall score. Round it off with how much everyone enjoyed the match.
- 5) Name the players and scorers.

The information required for a match report can be broken down into the following headings:

- Competition: e.g. Club Day / Blitz
- Score: e.g. 22 09
- Versus: e.g. Dolphin
- Venue: e.g. Musgrave Park
- Date: e.g. Saturday 10th September
- Match report: e.g. Constitution and Dolphin met for the second time in two
 weeks at Musgrave Park on Friday evening, this time it was in the semi final
 of the current season's Cork Charity Cup.
- Con Scorers: e.g. R. Lane 5P1C; D. Lyons 1T.
- Con Team: e.g. R. Clune, R. Lane, T. Kenneally, C Desmond..
- Con Substitutes: e.g. P. Kelleher, B. Cagney,
- Referee: e.g. P.O'Brien
